### **Key Information**

#### **Weigh in and registration:**

- In the clubhouse bar from 5pm to 8pm Wednesday and 9am to 11am Thursday.

#### **Craning in/out**

- John Hughes 0862549416 is our club member looking after craning and trailers.
- Forklift will shunt boats to and from the crane, please park your boats and move your car out of the boat parking area.
- Boats will be craned as they are ready each way, no blocking of the crane berths when lifting out if you're not ready to lift.
- Crane in from 1pm Wednesday until 8pm and 8am Thursday until 10am.

#### **Berthing/mooring**

- Boats will be berthed on the pontoon or moorings
- Access to the East Pier and down to the pontoon is 0862549416 John Hughes to get the barrier lifted

#### **Ferrying to moorings**

- Ferry pickup point will be the slipway beside the club
- There will be a club ferry on call fulltime during the event

#### **Club facilities**

- Clubhouse and bar opening:
  - Wednesday morning until late
  - Thursday 8:30am until late
  - Friday 8:30am until late
  - Saturday 8:30am until late
- Showers available in the clubhouse

#### **Food**
